





This visual guide will assist you in setting up and using Istation Home, which will allow your child to access the Istation Reading program.

<p>Step 1: Go to the Web site www.istation.com.</p>	
<p>Step 2: Hover your mouse over Support and select Download Istation.</p>	
<p>Step 3: Click the appropriate button to download Istation for Windows or Macintosh.</p>	
<p>Step 4: Type your school's domain name. You can just type your child's school's name in the box. Domain name format is: school.district.state (e.g., walter caldwell.polk.florida).</p>	
<p>Step 5:</p> <p>A. Enter your user name and password.</p> <p>B. Click the OK button.</p>

Click on **Reading with ISIP**.



Parents may go online to secure.istation.com to find a variety of support materials and activities to help reinforce children's learning at home.

The first time you log in, you will be prompted to select your child's school. Type in the school information.

Then type your login information as provided on the Parent Letter and click **Log On**.
